



## Alternative Sources of Funding

As SAFAC guidelines state, "SAFAC's role is to subsidize organizations' expenditures. SAFAC is not responsible for fully funding the totality of student organizations' operations. Student organizations are encouraged to seek outside sources of income." Some resources regarding alternative funding sources on campus are described below:

### **Event Sponsorships**

Organization	Details
<a href="#">Hurricane Productions</a>	Co-sponsorship for events that align with the Hurricane Productions mission. Apply on the HP Engage 3-4 weeks prior to the event and pitch to the HP executive board during their weekly meeting.
<a href="#">Late Night Programming Grant</a>	For events that fall on a Thurs-Sat after 8 pm, organizations can receive up to \$1,000 in funding for their event. Download the budget template and apply on SASO's Engage at least 4 weeks prior to the event.
<a href="#">Policy and Finance Committee</a>	Event funding for up to 10% of event cost based on organization's approved SAFAC budget. Apply on the Student Government Engage page 2 weeks prior to the event and present to the Policy and Finance committee during their weekly meeting.
<a href="#">SASO</a>	Co-sponsorship funding is available from the Department of Student Activities & Student Organizations for signature events that benefit UM students and/or the UM community. Apply on the SASO Engage page at least 4 weeks prior to the event.
